

GARBAGE DISPOSAL CONTRACT

This Garbage Disposal Contract is made and entered into this 2nd day of April, A.D 2026 by and between **NATIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (NTA)**, a legal entity solely owned by the Liberian Government, located at Japan Drive, formerly Somalia Drive, Gardnersville, represented by its Managing Director, Hon. Edmund Forh Forh, of the City of Monrovia, County of Montserrado, Republic of Liberia, hereinafter known and referred to as the **"ENTITY "** and **GREEN PLANET ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**, also a legal entity registered and existing under the laws of the Republic of Liberia with address at Gardnersville Township, Montserrado County, Republic of Liberia, represented by its Chief Operating Officer (COO), Mr. Gabriel A. Nyarko, also of the Township of Gardnersville, Republic of Liberia, herein after known and referred to as the **"SERVICE PROVIDER"**. The ENTITY and the SERVICE PROVIDER are also hereinafter collectively known and referred to as the **"PARTIES"**; hereby;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Entity is involved with mass transit activities through which commuters leave a lot of wastes /dirt on the floor of the buses, which are eventually cleaned on a daily basis and the garbage is piled up at the back of the garage building for disposal;

WHEREAS, the Entity has seen the need to dispose of this regular pile of garbage and want to retain its previous service provider until the FY 2026 procurement process is concluded to rid the entity of this garbage, which when unattended, could pose some serious health risks to the employees;

WHEREAS, the SERVICE PROVIDER has demonstrated competence in the discharge of its functions in implementing the desired service and has committed to continuously ensuring that the environment of the NTA remains clean at all times; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have both agreed to work in synergy, aimed at achieving their mutual goals;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises exchanged and agreements herein contained, the Parties do hereby agree to the following to wit:

COUNTS

1. That the **SERVICE PROVIDER** will rid the NTA's premises of all non-hazardous waste that will be collected from the transit buses and piled up at the back of the garage building by employees of the General Services Section of the Entity;
2. That the SERVICE PROVIDER shall make at least three (3) trips every week in the execution of its tasks of garbage disposal to avoid foul or pungent odor from the piled dirt, which could eventually pose some health issues;
3. That the **Parties** have mutually agreed that there shall be no stock pile of garbage in the NTA premises during the life span of this contract.
4. That the Entity will pay the Service Provider One Hundred Thirty United States Dollars (US\$130.00) every month for garbage removed and disposed of beginning April 2, 2026.
5. That the Parties hereto have mutually agreed that this Contract shall have a life span of nine (9) months commencing from the date of signing, April 2, 2026 up to December 31, 2026.

CONTRACT VALUE & PAYMENT TERMS

6. The total value of this Contract is **One Thousand One Hundred Seventy United States Dollars (US\$1,170.00)**, and payments shall be made on per-invoice basis as follows:

All payment invoices from the Service Provider shall be accompanied by a job completion report, signed by the head of the General Services Section or a designee, valid business and tax clearance certificates to facilitate the process.

GOVERNING LAW/ARBITRATION

- It is mutually agreed and understood by the Parties hereto that failing an amicable settlement, all disputes arising from this Agreement or related to it shall be finally settled in accordance with the Laws of the Republic of Liberia.

TERMINATION

- It is herein agreed by the parties that either party shall have the right to terminate this contract with cause upon thirty-day written notice in advance to the other party.

TAXES

- The Parties have agreed that, during the life span of this Contract, applicable taxes associated with the value of the contract and conduct of the business, during time of payment, shall be withheld by the **entity** and remitted to the GOL through the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) and a flag receipt obtained which shall be given to the **SERVICE PROVIDER**.

FORCE MAJEURE

- A party shall not be liable for any failure of or delay in the performance of this Agreement for the period that such failure or delay is due to an event of Force Majeure. The term "Force Majeure" as used in this Agreement shall mean acts of God, war, nationwide strikes or labor disputes, embargoes, blockades, revolutions, riots, civil commotions, fires, explosions, earthquakes, or any other natural disasters, or public health emergencies, provided any such cause was not within the reasonable control of the Party claiming the benefit of Force Majeure and could not have been avoided or overcome by such Party through the exercise of due diligence. In the event of force majeure, the contract shall be suspended for the duration of the force majeure.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- This contract and the attachments hereto made, constitute the entire agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter and supersede any other oral statements, discussions, representations or agreements made by either party to the other.

BINDING EFFECTS

- The terms and conditions stated above constitute an agreement between the parties stated in the preamble. Hence, no statement, promises and inducements made by any other party or agent or any party that is not contained in this agreement shall be valid or binding. The terms and conditions herein contained shall also be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal representatives, successors-in-business and assigns as though they were herein mentioned by names.

CONTRACT MODIFICATION OR EXTENSION

- The parties agreed that this contract may be modified in whole or in part only with the written consent of both parties and under terms and conditions to be negotiated. Any such modification shall be duly executed as an addendum, and may be requested by either party.

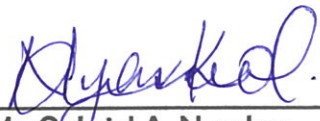
