

**TECHNICAL CONSULTANCY AND TRAINING CONTRACT**

This Technical Consultancy and Training Contract is made and entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, A.D. 2026, by and between the **National Transit Authority (NTA)**, a Public Corporation solely owned by the Liberian Government, located at Japan Drive, in the Township of Gardnersville, represented by its Managing Director, Hon. Edmund Forh Forh, of the City of Monrovia, County of Montserrado, Republic of Liberia, hereinafter known and referred to as the “**Client**” and **SITON VENTURES, KERALA, India**, represented by its Technical Consultant, Mr. Firoz Badarudeen, an Indian National, TATA technical mechanic/consultant and a resident of Republic of India, herein after known and referred to as the “**Consultant**”. Both the Client and the Consultant herein are collectively referred to as the “**Parties**”; hereby;

**WITNESSETH:**

1. That the Client, and approval of the Board of Directors, in a bid to expand and maintain its TATA Fleet visibility, technical training for its mechanics, investment and asset management, and explore alternative ways to source stakeholders’ investment opportunities, sought the expertise of a TATA technical mechanic/consultant that can adequately perform the desired tasks;
2. That the Client will be responsible to purchase the flight tickets (TO & FRO) for the consultant, provide full accommodation with all the necessary furniture, utensils and other utilities that maybe required for a smooth and healthy living in Liberia, as well as local transportation.
3. That in consideration of the past performance history of the Consultant to the Client, the Client hereby covenants, promises and agrees to offer the Consultant this contract to perform the following tasks on behalf of the Client:
  - Develop training plans and maintenance strategies aligned with fleet expansion, modernization, and service improvement;
  - Provide comprehensive technical training for mechanics at the National Transit Authority at all level.
  - Develop preventive maintenance and collective measures implementation into the workshop, in conjunction with the technical manager, local technical consultant and vehicle analyst consultant to assure the verification of materials and parts in stock, supplies model of vehicle and series recording;
  - In conjunction with the technical manager, monitor workshop leadership ability, mechanic assigned self-application to object, parts-handing, assembling and disassembling procedure;
  - Along with the technical manager repaired fleet from the workshop for engine compression, bearing noise, pulling system, cooling system and maximum engine oil pressure reading must be evaluated and tested before being placed in for operation;
  - Recommend efficiency improvements in operations and technical management;
  - Prepare monthly report for executives and stakeholders in conjunction with
  - Technical/Operational Manager;
  - The technical consultant shall perform other tasks/activities, as may be assigned by the Managing Director;
  - Recommend efficiency improvements in operations and technical management; and
  - All reports emanating from the technical consultant will be sent directly to the Managing Director
4. That the Client shall pay the Consultant a Monthly Service fee of **ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY UNITED STATES DOLLARS (US\$1,250.00)**, OR ITS LIBERIAN DOLLARS EQUIVALENT AT THE PREVAILING CENTRAL BANK OF LIBERIA’S RATE AT THE TIME OF PAYMENT. However, justification documentation for tasks undertaken monthly by the consultant shall be submitted to the Client and copy shared with Client’s Finance Section to process payment. Thus, the total Consultancy Fee is **TEN THOUSAND UNITED STATES DOLLARS (US\$10,000.00)**.
5. This Consultancy Contract takes effect April 29, 2026 and expires on December 31, 2026, with option to renew. The Contract duration is eight (8) months.
6. It is further understood and agreed by the Contracting Parties that should the Consultant have to perform services on behalf of the Client outside of Montserrado County, but within the Republic, the



Consultant shall be entitled to a per diem commensurate with the local travel ordinance as issued by the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning of the Republic of Liberia.

7. That the Parties understand and agree that during the life of this Technical Consultancy and Training Contract (April 27, 2026 to December 31, 2026), applicable taxes associated with the monthly value of the Contract (US\$1,250.00) shall be withheld by the Client and remitted to the APPROPRIATE REVENUE AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF LIBERIA and a flag receipt obtained therefrom shall be given to the Consultant by the Client, as evidence of the Consultant's payment of the appropriate tax.
8. It is mutually understood and agreed by the Contracting Parties herein that failing on an amicable settlement, all disputes arising out of this Consultancy Service Contract shall be submitted to Arbitration in accordance with chapter 64. ARBITRATION, Title 1, Liberia Code of Laws Revised.
9. It is also mutually understood and agreed by the Contracting Parties that either party reserves the right to terminate this contract for cause, upon the aggrieved party serving thirty (30) days written advance notice on the other party. Also, both parties shall maintain the confidentiality of all financial information shared during this engagement.
10. In the event of force majeure, the Parties hereto mutually agree that the performance of this Contract shall be suspended until normal conditions are restored.
  - a) Force majeure is herein defined as natural disasters, acts of God, war, civil disturbances which shall hinder, delay or make impossible the performance of this Contract.
  - b) Any time which may be lost due to the occurrence of force majeure shall be added to the remaining time of the contract.
11. The Parties agreed that the governing law of this Legal Service Contract shall be the Laws of the Republic of Liberia.
12. This instrument contains the entirety of the agreement between the Parties hereto and it is intended to be the complete and exclusive statement of the terms and conditions of this Technical Consultancy and Training Contract. There are no other agreements or understanding(s), [oral or written], between the Parties in respect of transaction. No modification or verification hereof shall be valid unless the same is expressly agreed to and approved by the contracting Parties in writing. This Contract supersedes all other communications, oral or written, in connection with this Consultancy Service Contract.
13. This Technical Consultancy and Training Contract shall be binding on the Parties, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal representatives, successors-in-office and assigns as though they were herein mentioned by names.
